Position Responsibilities

- Develop an understanding of proper planting, mulching, watering, and trimming techniques
- Communicate effectively with foreman and other departments
- Complete other tasks assigned by the supervisor
- Check Department of Transportation truck basics
- Load trucks each morning for efficient transport to job sites
- Walk through site with the foreman to discuss the expectations of the job
- Work independently or as a team to execute plan according to the standards of Campbell's and the landscape designer
- Load truck and trailer, ensure jobsite is clean and tools are accounted for
- Properly account for any deviations between original work order and final ticket
- Return completed tickets to supervisor for billing in a timely manner

Physical Requirements

- Be prepared to work in all weather conditions (rain, snow and temperatures from -30 to 105F)
- Be able or willing to learn to operate, repair (minor), and maintain landscape equipment.
- Be able to repeatedly lift 100 lbs. using proper lifting techniques and move up to 200 lbs. using proper technique.
- Be able to stoop, bend, and reach
- Be exposed to excessive noise from power equipment, saws, etc. (personal protective equipment available).
- Be exposed to chemicals and insecticides.
